Chief Noffsinger provided an update on the events and meetings held for the month of March 2022. Captain Reed provided the Shift and Training Reports. Chief Noffsinger provided some information about the FDAC Conference noting that there are some training opportunities for officers. The Chief is considering sending the captains to attend. The Chief noted that the FDAC has a committee that is working on the ERAF funding that was taken from Special Districts to fund schools noting that in 2019 \$230,000 was taken from Linden-Peters Fire Department. The FDAC is working to create awareness and possibly stop the ERAF. The Chief noted that at the conference he was made aware of some medical insurance programs that may be a cost savings for the District. Staff will begin to look into the insurance program options.
